## PIERRE-MARIE CHERMETTE BEAUJOLAIS BLANC 2015

Aromas of stones, minerals and acacia. Hints of cooked apples and lemons. Flint, too. Medium-to full-bodied, bright and fresh with pretty acidity. One of the best Beaujolais blancs I have tasted. Formerly Domaine du Vissoux. Drink now.

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## DOMAINE DU VISSOUX BEAUJOLAIS CŒUR DE VENDANGES VIGNES CENTENAIRES 2015

Very fruity with lots of crushed berries and spices. Blueberries. Medium to full body and round and soft tannins. Fruity and juicy. Will be renamed Pierre-Marie Chermette starting with the 2016 vintage. Drink now.

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## DOMAINE DU VISSOUX BEAUJOLAIS LES GRIOTTES 2015

Extremely perfumed with blackberries, blueberries and lemon rind. Full body, rich and medium tannins and a flavorful finish. Will be renamed Pierre-Marie Chermette starting with the 2016 vintage. Drink or hold.

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## PIERRE-MARIE CHERMETTE BEAUJOLAIS ROSÉ LES GRIOTTES 2015

A fresh and tangy rosé with peach and light plum character. Medium body and fresh acidity. Formerly Domaine du Vissoux. Drink now.

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## PIERRE-MARIE CHERMETTE BEAUJOLAIS PRIMEUR VIEILLES VIGNES 2016

The cherry and bark aromas are fresh and enticing. Medium body, light tannins and bright acidity. Fresh and flavorful. Holding on nicely for a primeur. Formerly Domaine du Vissoux. Drink now.

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## PIERRE-MARIE CHERMETTE BEAUJOLAIS LES GRIOTTES 2016

An attractive wine with blueberry and cherry character as well as hints of wet earth. Medium body, light tannins and a flavorful finish. Formerly Domaine du Vissoux. Drink now.
